## TREE HOUSE

Single Family Residence







About the project: Located in Austin, Texas.

> From the beging design was to incorporate a giant pecan tree that was situated in the middle of the property. Other geographical restraints required for us to divide the project into two halves. The first part of the house was at street level and the other began at the bottom and back of the property so we litterally bridged the two ends and created the core of the residence, which is the center of the tree.

> East Austin began to be gentrified a couple of years befor the design of the tree house began, and so the program was to create a comfortable home, with modern asthetics and requirements. So the challenge was to do a custom residence that would blend with the scale of the vernacular, and so a we created a low profile hundred foot ramp-roof that followed the slope of the hill, so as to be inconspicuous in a neighboor whose houses were an avarage of a thousand saft.

Green construction and new light gauge steel construction building systems were used in the builiding of this house, making it - at the time, one of the only projects of it's kind in Austin.
